Theme: "The Spirit of Dunbar"

INFORMATION AND RULES

The theme is "The Spirit of Dunbar". This could be something that springs to mind when you think of Dunbar, for example its beaches, sea, harbour, farmland, woodland, a person/people, an activity or business, something historical or new, anything you love about Dunbar and helps define its Spirit.

1. The competition is open to everyone in Dunbar.
2. There will be prizes in 3 categories - Best dressed House, Best dressed Window and Best dressed Scarecrow.
3. Businesses and shops are welcome to join in too.
4. Keep it clean and not too scary – remember it's a family friendly competition.
5. For outdoor displays, make sure that it is secure and won't blow away!

Prizes

6. Prizes will be in the form of vouchers redeemable at local Dunbar shops and businesses.
7. There will be a first, second and third prize in each of the three categories. The value of the prizes are first £100, second £50 and third £25.

How to enter

8. Dress up the outside of your house, your window, or make a scarecrow - take a photograph and send it in **via Facebook messenger** or **email dunbarcivicweek@outlook.com** and we will post it on our Facebook page, website, Twitter and Instagram. By entering, you agree to us sharing your entry online at the aforementioned places.
9. Scarecrow - you do not need to include straw, old clothes will do, or anything else to hand, be creative!
10. Civic Week bunting - include a bit of Civic Week blue and yellow coloured bunting in the design - we're not expecting you to buy this but hopefully make it from eg. scrap paper, cardboard, cloth, wool, string, recycled materials etc.
11. Send in a photo of your display by **midnight, Thursday 10th June**.
12. Include your name, address and a title for your 'Best Dressed' display when you send in your photo. We may share the street address of your entry in social media publicity, but not the actual house/flat number. And, if you are one of the lucky winners, we will deliver the vouchers to your address.
13. Displays to be up in June and for the full Civic Week of 12th-19th June.
14. Entries will be judged over the weekend of the 12th - 13th June by the Civic Week organising committee and winners announced soon after.
